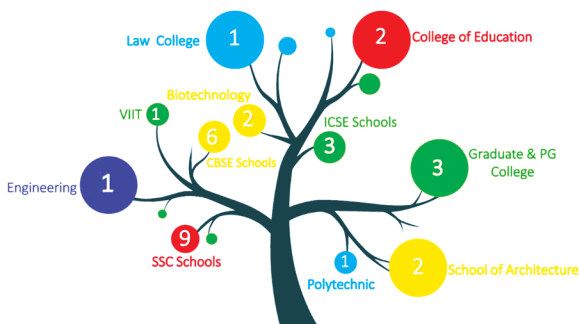

In pursuit of Institution's Innovation Council

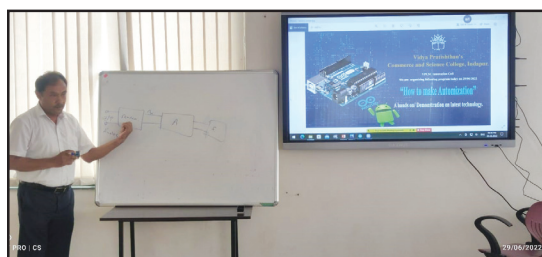

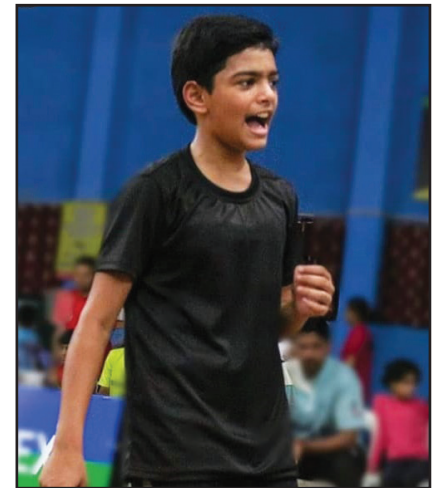
