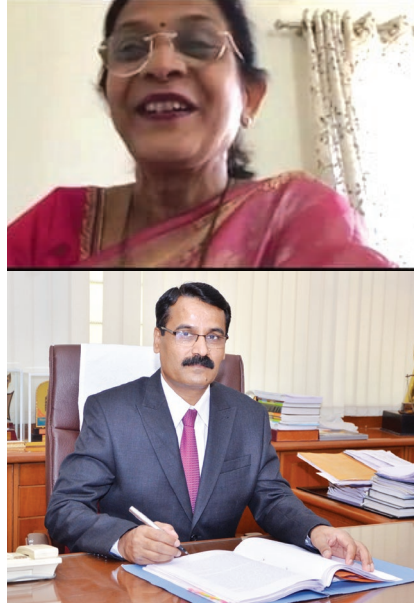

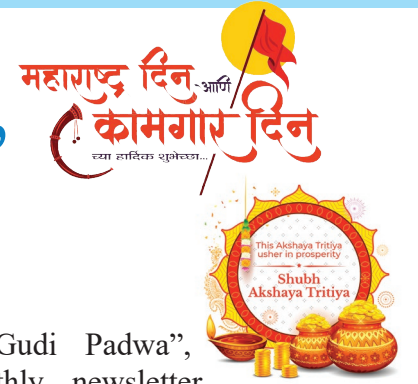
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“Vidya Pratishthan reflects, It’s heritage through It’s newsletter Vidya Vaarta”

Most students, however, have now had a lot of in-school practice.. Maharashtra state board has already wrapped up its SSC and HSC exams.

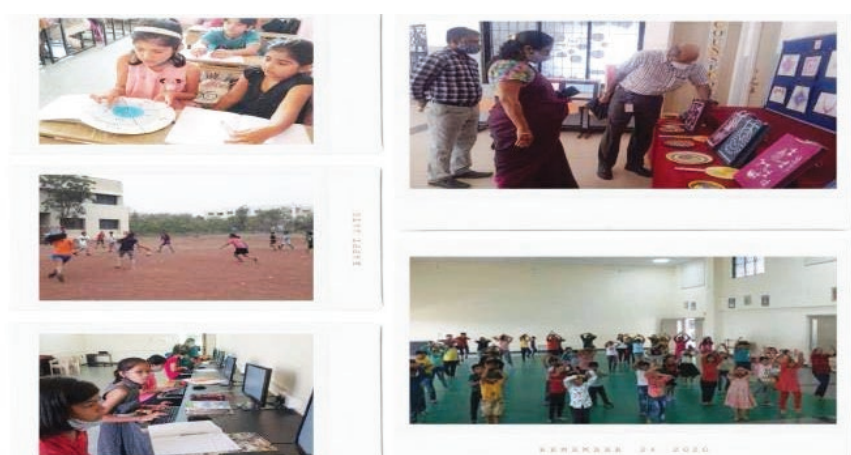
Mr. Vijay Naval honored by "Vidarbh Gaurav Award".
